

American University Hillel Student Initiative Grants for 2007 2008 Academic Year

Purpose of grants:

The grants are intended to promote opportunities for individual students and student groups to develop programs and initiatives which are consistent with the mission of American University Hillel: *to foster vibrant Jewish life on campus in a welcoming, pluralistic atmosphere.*

Applications for grants will be accepted on a rolling basis and grants will be awarded as long as there are available funds.

Grants will be for a maximum of \$250.

Who may apply?:

AU student organizations or individuals on behalf of informal groups of students. Grant applications need to be signed by the chair of the organization and one other officer. In the case of informal groups, five signatures will be required.

How to apply:

Send applications to Rabbi Ken Cohen (rabbi@american.edu) with the words: **AU Hillel Student Grants {Name of group applying}.**

Expect to hear from us about your application within 7-10 days.

How the funds will be dispersed:

Once a grant is awarded, students can arrange to have invoices sent to AU Hillel or can apply for reimbursement for out of pocket expenses. Receipts are requested for all expenses and are required for any expenditure above \$25.
